# Louis DeJoy and Aldona Wos Host Estonian TFAS Alumni and Dignitaries in Tallinn, Estonia

Louis DeJoy and Dr. Aldona Wos (former U.S. Ambassador to Estonia) traveled to Estonia to host a reception for alumni of The Fund for American Studies (TFAS) and Estonian Dignitaries at the Radisson Blu Sky Hotel in Tallinn, Estonia. Nearly 100 people were invited to the event.

The event focused on alumni engagement, continuing education, encouraging alumni to meet regularly in the future for networking and to helping each other in their careers and in their work on behalf of shared values. Alumni were also asked to help in identifying strong candidates for future TFAS programs.

Since 2006, the DeJoyWos Family Foundation has sponsored 47 of the 87 Estonian students that have attended TFAS programs in Washington, DC.

The TFAS mission is to prepare leaders who are honorable leaders and have a commitment to the values that underpin a free society. TFAS programs reach students throughout the U.S., Europe, Asia, and South & Central America. Programs also reach young people from high school to university to early career professionals. We call this the TFAS Journey.

In 2018, more than 1,500 students, teachers and young professionals attended TFAS programs throughout the world. This includes programs at Charles University in Prague, Los Andes University in Santiago, Chile, the University of Hong Kong, and George Mason University in Washington, DC. TFAS programs were also held on college campuses across the U.S., including Yale, Cornell, Tufts, Berkeley, Rice, Wake Forest and the University of Colorado.

TFAS graduates are making a difference throughout the world. They are journalists, members of the U.S. Congress, and leaders in business, law, public policy, government and the non-profit sector.
