## **The *Louis DeJoy and Aldona Z. Wos Family Foundation* Supports the 2019 Winston-Salem Open**

### **The Foundation Hosts Reception for Elon University's *Elon Village Families* and *Elon Odyssey Scholars***

The DEJOY\WOS Family Foundation has supported the Winston-Salem Open, a men's professional tennis tournament played on the ATP Tour at Wake Forest University in Winston-Salem, North Carolina, since its debut in 2011. Louis DeJoy began sponsoring the event when he was Chairman and CEO of New Breed Logistics, and in 2015 continued the sponsorship through the DEJOY\WOS Family Foundation.

In addition to sponsoring the Winston-Salem Open, the DEJOY\WOS Family Foundation hosted a reception for groups of children and their families from Elon University's *Elon Village Families* and *Elon Odyssey Scholars*.



The Winston-Salem Open is a charitable non-profit whose proceeds benefit many local charities. The primary charitable partner is the Winston-Salem / Forsyth County Schools middle school athletic programs. The Winston-Salem Open proceeds helped bring back Cross Country programs and expand Tennis to all of the middle schools in Forsyth County.

The US Open Series has established itself as a true regular season of hard court tennis, linking seven summer tournaments to the US Open. Fans follow the action throughout the summer through national television coverage, culminating each week with back-to-back men's and women's finals every Sunday afternoon.
